

Current Facts - June 25, 2012

The following facts have been collected from the following sources: Members' comments from Facebook Groups Ocean X & Ocean X Moderated Discussion Board, Quotes from Peter Lindberg and Dennis Asberg, and the following internet website - http://newsfeedresearcher.com/data/articles_t25/object-team-baltic.html (It is possible that some portions have also been taken from various other reputable websites. If there are any discrepancies, they should be listed in the comments section.)

1. THE CIRCULAR ROCK FORMATION:

- lies approximately 80 meters deep
- 60 meters (197 feet) in width
- The Circle actually consists of smaller stone boulders, measuring 8 feet wide and 26 feet long, in a circular rock formation
- 4 meters thick, is sitting on a 8 meter high pillar which is 56 or 58 meters - total height of formation is raised 12 meters off the seabed. Peter said the top part of the pillar sticks out only a couple of meters at the wider part
- The stones are separated by channels and resembled sandstone, "the kind divers see in keys and harbours
- here are visible formations on top of the object which, are set at a 90 degree angle and look like passages or walls, as well as something that looks like a staircase

2. THE DOME-LIKE OBJECT (latest picture shows portion of this object)

- round and dome-shaped in form - referred to as a "meringue"
- formation which sits directly on top of the 60 meter rock formation, located on edge of rock formation, right side of sonar scan
- **NOTE:** Not clear on the width of this object!
- appears to be covered in some type of hard cement-like substance
- after being chipped, the interior of object is black, like volcanic rock, almost petrified inside. Material is very hard, not simple stone, described as "preserved rock". Hogeborn describes the sense of carbonized material
- in the center, it has an oblong hole (about 5.9 to 9.8 inches wide), six inches that go into it. It's not known yet where it leads.
- rounded sides with rugged edges (not smooth) of the divers had said: "When we had swum across the object, we get to the next weird thing. Then it's like someone has pinched the mountain at the edge, as if you have moulded together two molds, and it sticks out stones between the molds, said Stefan Hogeborn." (taken from article on Expressen.se)
- there are straight edges
- lying on top of the object are strange circular rock formations, like "fireplaces", of hard black "almost petrified" burnt looking stone each a few inches in diameter, like 4 or 5 pearls in a necklace. These stones are covered in something resembling soot.
- appears to have construction lines and boxes drawn on it (quote, Lindberg)
- "the surface has cracks on it," said Lindberg. "There is some black material in the cracks, but we don't know what it is."
- the rock isn't covered at all in silt, which should have typically occurred on the bottom of the sea, Lindberg said.
- There are other, loose stones lying around as well
- object is rare and something the crew has never seen before
- no radiation has been detected
- electromagnetic disturbances (video and cell phone blackout) have been detected when approaching within 200 meters in the location of the object

THE "TRAIL / PATH":

- The 1500 meter path to the object itself can be described as a "runway or a downhill path" that is flattened at the seabed with the object at the end of it. Peter Lindberg believes that the path, or the track, is a ridge raising slowly up from the bottom to a height of approx 8 meters above the surrounding bottom. I also believe that the ridge is made of softer material than the pillar and the circle.
