06.00	Yesterday, after their daily routine, Madeline went to bed at around 7.30pm. They were placed in their respective beds and he dresses they were placed together (i.e. in the same bedroom), at about 19.30." The witness and his wife, between this time and 20.30 stayed in the apartment relaxing and drinking a glass of wine.	After the daily routine, Madeline and the twins went to bed at around 7.30pm. They were in their respective beds. The interviewee and her husband stayed in their apartment to relax until 8.30pm.				Concerning the children, she is a happy child, good natured and full of energy. She can sleep well and a stranger could take her without her shouting or crying. She is a smart child who knows right from wrong. They had the habit of going to the swimming pool in the tourist complex which is about 50 metres from the apartments as the restaurant is about 50 metres round the building to the back entrance	every evening the group was to be found at the, "Tapas," dining, at around 8.45 for dinner. While the adults were eating, the children were sleeping in their respective apartments.		Concerning the usual routines, the informant states that she and her husband stay at home with their family and that not always. Sometimes she reads, she went shopping or did other things. On the other days, she spent the mornings playing tennis.
21.00 Uhr (8.00 pm)	After 20.30, the witness and his wife, after checking on the children, went to the Tapas Bar, about 50 metres away, where they had dinner. As usual, they had dinner as the restaurant was near, the witness and his wife, would check whether the children were all right.	Just after 8.30pm, the interviewee and her husband, after checking on the children, joined the other adults of the group at the "TAPAS" restaurant, about 50 metres away, where they had dinner. As usual, they had dinner as the restaurant was near, the witness and her husband went to make sure the children were OK.	The witness went for dinner at the Tapas restaurant at about 20.30. Yesterday, at around 8.45pm, like every evening, joined the rest of the group to eat at the, "tapas," restaurant	The states that he, his wife and his mother-in-law arrived at the restaurant at around 8.50pm. According to what he remembers, the group had dinner at the restaurant. The group were present, apart from the children who were in bed. During the evening, Gerry, Jane and Matthew went, along with the other adults, to the swimming pool as the children were sleeping. He thinks they physically went into the apartments. He no longer remembers in what order they went see their children.		
21.00 Uhr (9.00 PM)	In this way, at about 21.05 the witness came to the Club, where he met his friend Matt (member of the group) who was holding the key, the door being locked. He went back to the restaurant, and his husband said that the children were doing well, as was Madeline. "He then decided to go to the swimming pool where he had a few moments, left, and bumped into a person whom he had played tennis, a person who has two children. At this point he saw Gerry talking to an Englishman called Jez whom they had got to know during the holidays. It was normal that every 15 minutes, one person from each apartment would go to the apartments/bedrooms make sure the children were OK.	That around 9.05pm, the interviewee went to the area of the apartments. Notably to the area near the windows of all the children's bedrooms.	Her husband Matthew, went to look for David Payne and Fiona Payne. At around 9pm, the couple were followed by two other adults, Gerry and Jane. He had been to check the children's bedrooms, his own apartment where his daughter was sleeping but also that of the twins and Madeline. He had been to check the bedrooms but didn't hear any noise. He also checked to see if there was any noise in Russell O'Brien and Jane Tanner's apartment. He said that he hadn't heard any noise.			They left the apartment at around 8.45 and accompanied by her son, went to the Club. There, they went to join the rest of the group at the "TAPAS" restaurant. The McCann couple were amongst the other friends at dinner. To our question, the informant told us that the group had dinner at the restaurant, allowing them to hear if the children were shouting or crying, no one went to bed on the spot. However, she remembers Kate and Gerry talking to each other, couples went a few times, on a regular basis, to make sure their children were OK.
At about 21.30 his friend Matt (member of the group) went to the apartment, where his children were sleeping, to check on the children. He went into the witness' apartment, entering by means of a glass sliding door that was always unlocked and with the key in his pocket. When he entered the bedroom, he observed the twins and he did not notice even though Madeline was there."	Around 9.30pm was the time the interviewee should have gone to see Madeline, as well as friend Matt (a member of the group) who had come to the apartment to check on the children. He had entered the apartment by a glass sliding side door, that was always unlocked and once inside had not heard any noise. He had gone to the restaurant and said that everything was fine.	Meanwhile a man appeared (*) carrying a child (**), with a hurried walk. The entrance to the apartment was through a (1) balcony or terrace (street) where the individual appeared from.	He recalls that Matthew Oldfield left the restaurant shortly after 9pm to check the children. He is no longer sure about the time. At around 9.15pm, he and Gerry McCann and his own partner, Jane, went out, along with the other friends at dinner. To our question, the informant told us that the group had dinner at the restaurant, allowing them to hear if the children were shouting or crying, no one went to bed on the spot. However, she remembers Kate and Gerry talking to each other, couples went a few times, on a regular basis, to make sure their children were OK.	After placing their orders, at around 9.15pm, Gerry McCann went to check, only his apartment. He was held up for nearly 10 minutes as he had to check his apartment and the window about ten times. During Gerry's absence, the waiters started to bring the food. Before Gerry arrived Jane Michelle Tanner also left the restaurant. At around 9.25pm, the waiter came back. A little later Jane arrived. Between the starters and the main course, at around 9.30pm, her husband Matthew Oldfield went to check on the children. Kate also was planning to go and see the children. Gerry told her it was no trouble, that they would go and check.					During one of these checks, Kate came back.
At about 22.00 it was his wife Kate who went to check on the children	At around 10pm, the interviewee went to check on the children. She went into the apartment by the side door, which was closed but not locked, as she said before. She noticed that the door to her bedroom was open. The window and the shutter were also open, the shutters raised and the curtains open, while she was certain of having closed them all as she always did.	When she was in the apartment, at about 22.00.	At around 10pm, Kate, Madeline's mother, went to her children in her apartment	At around 10pm, Kate, Madeline's mother, went to her apartment to check on her children. She came back totally shocked, shouting, saying that Madeline was no longer in her bed. At that moment, the window and the shutter were open, the shutters raised and the curtains open, while she was certain of having closed them all as she always did.	At around 10pm, Kate went to her own to check her children. She came back to the restaurant in tears and told us that Madeline had disappeared.	Towards 10pm, Kate went to her apartment, and less than 5 minutes later, she came back to the restaurant, breaking down, reporting that Madeline had disappeared. Then people from the restaurant and the police went to the witness's family. He remembers comments concerning the fact that the window and the shutters were open, while they had remained closed throughout the week.			They immediately organised search parties, in the apartment, thinking that she could be hiding in there, then outside. In spite of help from the Ocean Club's employees, they could not find her.
10 pm	Later, a member of the group, according to Kate, when she went to the apartment to see her children at around 11.30pm, saw from the back (rear) about 50 metres away, on the perimeter road of the club, a long-haired person, in what she described as a tourist complex, who was walking very quickly. But she is better able to tell you about that herself.	Faced with this situation, she verified that the twins were in their respective beds, while Madeline, who had disappeared. The cover was pulled over and the toys were on the play mat as usual. After seeing the whole complex, she went to the restaurant, the interviewee went back, scared and shocked, to the restaurant, the group then set about searching for Madeline throughout the complex, looked in all the buildings, swimming pool, tennis courts etc... as well as in the apartment with the help of employees, who, at the same time, contacted the authorities.	Question: And outside the group?	We all went to the tourist complex to look for her. They went all inside and some went to the apartment to check & in fact Madeline had disappeared, it having been confirmed. The twins carried on sleeping. They didn't move. The interviewee said that she had seen a person walking very quickly to the front of the apartment was found open with the shutter raised. The couple had never opened the shutters during their stay. After this they began to search and called the police.	The informant, who is a very withdrawn person, concerning the couple Gerry and Kate, neither with their children nor, notably, with Madeline. In the context of the group, he noticed nothing abnormal. That during the whole holiday, and particularly the night when Madeline disappeared, nothing unusual happened in the tourist complex, which attracted his attention, or which could be correlated with Madeline's disappearance.			She knew Madeline well and describes her as very attractive and she would not go with stranger without screaming or protesting unless she was very tired or sleeping.	
					He describes Madeline as being a commanding girl, happy, cheerful, very sociable. His wife and his partner are very sociable people, known lots of people, kind and affectionate. They are both very good parents, good elements of the couple. She was wanted and is the result of, "In Vitro," fertilisation. There was no difference in treatment between her and other women. She is healthy. Madeline suffers from any illness, nor is she on medication. He has nothing more to say that could help the progress of the investigation.			As regards the episode with Jane - she [Jane] only told her that she had seen an individual with a child in his arms, walking quickly. During this holiday she never noticed anything strange or relevant to the facts in question. No more was said.
