On 11-17-22, at 1430 hours, I responded to the University of Idaho Kibbie Dome to interview J [REDACTED] N [REDACTED]. Cpt. Berrett stated N [REDACTED] possibly had information regarding the homicide. N [REDACTED] took Det. Deane and myself to a conference room to speak.

N [REDACTED] stated on Sunday 11-13-22, between 0900 hours and 1000 hours he was walking his dog. He stated when he walked by the first time he noticed the front door to 1122 King Rd. on the north side of the building facing campus was wide open. He stated he knew it was a party house so assumed someone was too intoxicated and forgot to close the door the night prior. N [REDACTED] stated he walked his dog up Taylor Ave. to Blake Ave then down Sweet Ave. He said the walk took him approximately 1 hour. N [REDACTED] stated when he walked back to his apartment around 1100 hours the front door was still wide open. N [REDACTED] said he was unsure if the information was known or not but thought he should report it.

I asked N [REDACTED] if he knew anyone who lived in the house. He said not personally but in passing. I thanked N [REDACTED] and cleared.
